

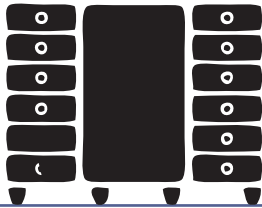
CHUCK IT FOR CHARITY

- ◆ Non-perishable food items



NOT ACCEPTED

- ◆ Beds
- ◆ Mattresses/box springs
- ◆ Rugs
- ◆ Appliances
- ◆ Anything with a plug
- ◆ Large metal desks
